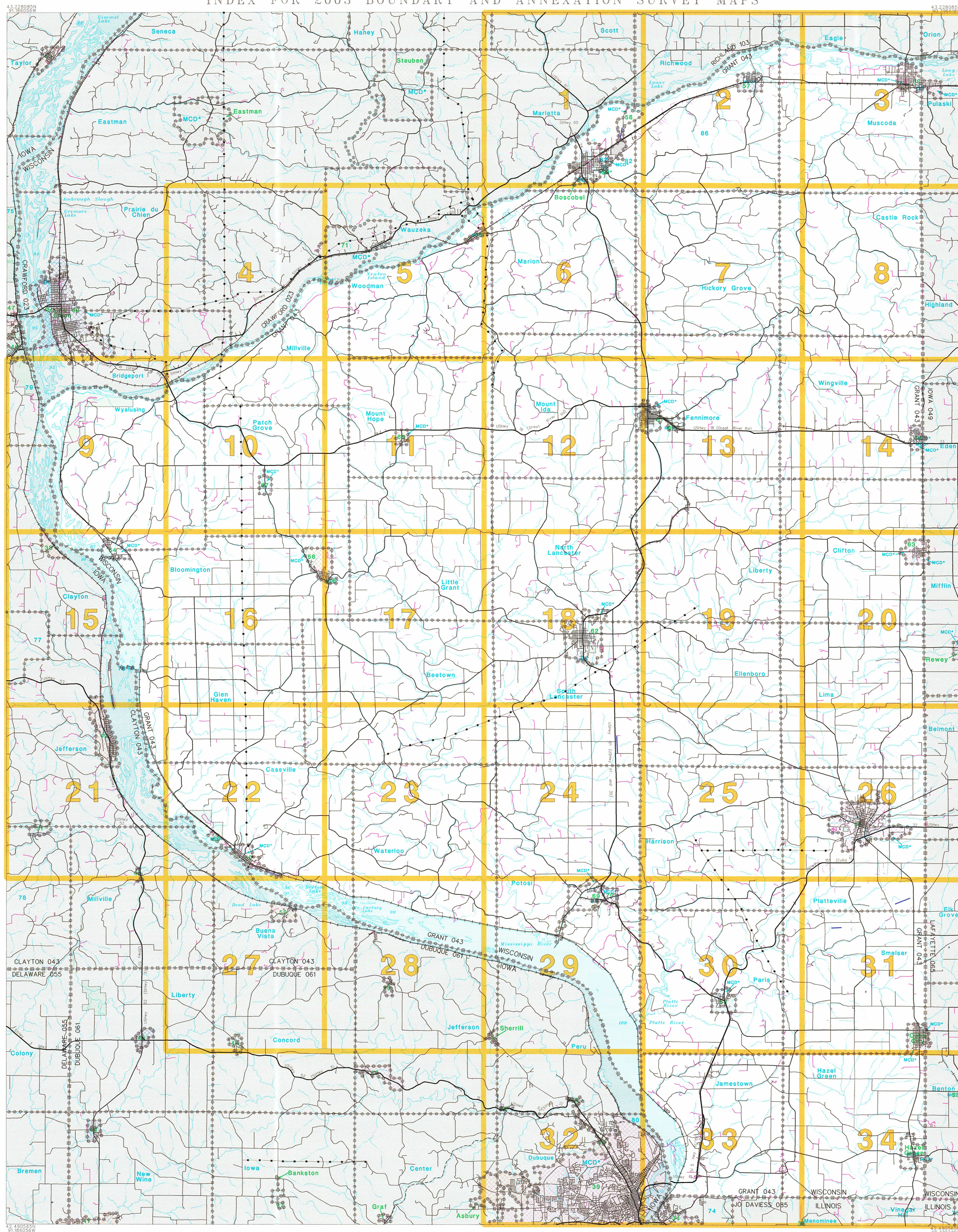

<sup>5</sup> For some street segment sides, the TIGER data base contains anomalous address range situations. When this occurs, the segment side will be simplified to a single address range. Possible anomalous situations include gaps in structure number ranges, odd and even structure numbers on the same segment side, and other inconsistencies.
