

RELOCATION ORDER

BY COUNTY HIGHWAY COMMITTEE OF GRANT COUNTY, WISCONSIN

THE COUNTY HIGHWAY COMMITTEE FINDS AND DETERMINES THAT:

The proper establishing, laying out, widening, enlarging, extending, constructing, reconstructing, improving, or maintaining a portion of the highway now designated as County Trunk Highway "E" from a point 960 feet west and 84 feet north of the S.E. corner of Section 14, Township 5 North, Range 2 West, and extending northeasterly to a point 780 feet west and 865 feet south of the E.1/4 corner of Section 13, Township 5 North, Range 4 West, and on roads or lands in and about and along and leading to same, requires certain relocation or change and the acquisition of lands or interests in lands as shown on the map or copy thereof marked

"PLAT OF RIGHT OF WAY REQUIRED, PROJECT S 0212(2)

for the Stitzer-Livingston Road

C.T.H. "E", Grant County, dated December 3, 1953."

Pursuant to its authority under Section 83.08, Wisconsin Statutes,

THE COUNTY HIGHWAY COMMITTEE HEREBY ORDERS THAT:

(1) The said highway is hereby laid out and established to the lines and widths as shown on the said plat.

(2) The required lands or interests in lands as shown on the plat shall be acquired by the County Highway Committee of the county in which the lands are situate, pursuant to the provisions of Section 83.08, Wisconsin Statutes.
