

RELOCATION ORDER

BY COUNTY HIGHWAY COMMITTEE OF GRANT COUNTY, WISCONSIN

THE GRANT COUNTY HIGHWAY COMMITTEE FINDS AND DETERMINES THAT:

The proper establishing, laying out, widening, enlarging, extending, reconstructing, improving, or maintaining a portion of the highway now designated as County Trunk Highway "F" from a point 685 feet East and 1240 feet South of the northwest corner of Section 9, Township 5 North, Range 2 West,

Thence northerly to a point 40 feet North and 14 feet West of the Northwest corner of Section 28, Township 6 North, Range 2 West,

And on roads or lands in and about and along and leading to same, requires certain relocation or change and the acquisition of lands or interests in lands as shown on the map or copy therefor marked,

"PLAT OF RIGHT OF WAY REQUIRED, PROJECT SC0212 (1)", Stitzer - U.S.H. 18 Road, C.T.H. "F", Grant County, dated March 8, 1960, the same being sheet No. 4 of the plans for the said project, and

Pursuant to its authority under Section 83.08, Wisconsin Statutes,

THE GRANT COUNTY HIGHWAY COMMITTEE ORDERS THAT:

- (1) The said highway is hereby laid out and established to the lines and width as shown on the said plat.
- (2) The required lands and interests in lands as shown on the plat shall be acquired by the County Highway Committee, pursuant to the provisions of Section 83.08, Wisconsin Statutes.

The foregoing order was issued by the County Highway Committee and entered in the minutes of its meeting on March 10, 1960.
