

RELOCATION ORDER

BY COUNTY HIGHWAY COMMITTEE OF GRANT COUNTY, WISCONSIN

THE COUNTY HIGHWAY COMMITTEE FINDS AND DETERMINES THAT:

The proper establishing, laying out, widening, enlarging, extending, constructing, reconstructing, improving, or maintaining a portion of the highway now designated as County Trunk Highway "K", from a point

1250 feet east of South one-quarter corner of Section 34, Township 5 North,

Range 3 West; extending thence northerly to a point 1645 feet east of

North West corner of Section 9, Township 5 North, Range 3 West,

and on roads or lands in and about and along and leading to same, requires certain relocation or change and the acquisition of lands or interests in lands as shown on the map or copy thereof marked,

"PLAT OF RIGHT OF WAY REQUIRED, PROJECT E0211(13)(K-1)" for the Lancaster-Mt. Ida Road, County Trunk Highway "K", Grant County, Dated April 18, 1949, the same being sheets 1 to 11 inclusive, and

Pursuant to its authority under Section 83.08, Wisconsin Statutes,

THE COUNTY HIGHWAY COMMITTEE HEREBY ORDERS THAT:

(1) The said highway is hereby laid out and established to the lines and widths as shown on the said plat.

(2) The required lands or interests in lands as shown on the plat shall be acquired by the County Highway Committee of the county in which the lands are situated, pursuant to the provisions of Section 83.08, Wisconsin Statutes.

(3) This order supersedes and amends the previous order issued by the County Highway Committee on July 8th 1948
