ORDER BY GRANT COUNTY HIGHWAY COMMISSION
FOR
RELOCATION AND ACQUISITION OF RIGHTS OF WAY
ON
COUNTY TRUNK HIGHWAY "X"

WHEREAS, the County Highway Commission of Grant County finds that the proper improvement or maintenance of the above Federal Aid Highway in the Town of Wyalusing, Grant County, from a point:

Beginning at a point known as Station 7+00 on the following described reference line, said point being 2,634. feet South and 2,393. feet West of the North $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 29, T6N, R6W, of Grant County, Wisconsin; thence along said reference line N $74^{\circ} 48'$ E for 121.35 to a point of curvature also known as Station 8+21.35; thence 217.64 feet Northeasterly along the arc of a curve concave to the Northwest with a radius of 477.46 feet to a point of tangency also known as Station 10+38.99; thence N $48^{\circ} 41'$ E for 755.05 to a point of curvature also known as Station 17+94.04; thence Northeasterly along the arc of a curve concave to the Northwest with a radius of 1145.92' for a distance of 197.67' to a point of tangency known as Station 19+91.71;

requires certain relocations or changes, and the acquisition of certain Rights-of-Way as shown on the attached plat marked "Plat of Right of Way Required", C.T.H. "X", Grant County, dated 9-9-1982.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, under authority granted by Section 83.08, Wisconsin Statutes, that said County Highway be and is hereby changed or relocated and that Rights-of-Way be acquired in accordance with said plat.
