

RELOCATION ORDER

BY COUNTY HIGHWAY COMMITTEE OF GRANT COUNTY, WISCONSIN

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THE COUNTY HIGHWAY COMMITTEE FINDS AND DETERMINES THAT:

The proper establishing, laying out, widening, enlarging, extending, constructing, reconstructing, improving, or maintaining a portion of the highway now designated as County Trunk Highway "ZZ" from a point

5194 feet South and 188 feet West of the

Northwest Corner Section 31, Township 1 North,

Range 1 West, extending thence Northerly to a

Point 90 feet South of the Northwest Corner Section 31,

Township 1 North, Range 1 West thereof.

"PLAT OF RIGHT OF WAY REQUIRED," PROJECT ZZ-1 for the County Trunk Highway "ZZ" located between the Illinois State Line and County Trunk Highway "Z" in Grant County, dated June 14, 1956, the same being sheet No. 1 and

Pursuant to its authority under Section 83.08, Wisconsin Statutes,

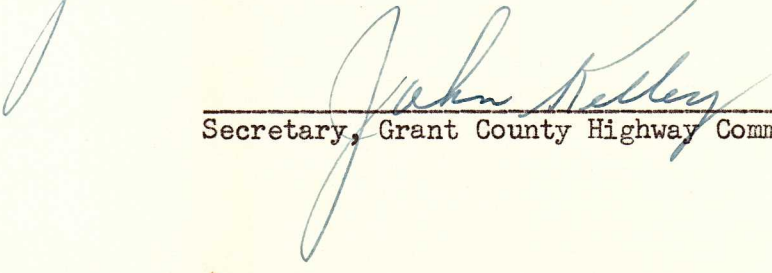
THE COUNTY HIGHWAY COMMITTEE ORDERS THAT:

- (1) The said highway is hereby laid out and established to the lines and widths as shown on the said plat.
- (2) The required lands or interests in lands as shown on the plat shall be acquired by the County Highway Committee of the County in which the lands are situated, pursuant to the provision of Section 83.08, Wisconsin Statutes.
