

JURISDICTIONAL TRANSFER AGREEMENT

This agreement, entered into this 20th day of July, 1991<sup>2</sup>, by and between the Department of Transportation of the State of Wisconsin, hereinafter called the State, and the Board of Supervisors of Grant County, hereinafter called the County:

WITNESSETH THAT:

WHEREAS, the functional/jurisdictional relationship of present State and County Trunk Highway systems have been cooperatively reviewed by the Grant County Highway Committee and the State, and

WHEREAS, changes in the jurisdiction of these highway systems in the County have been agreed to by the County and the State, and

WHEREAS, consistent with those agreed-to changes, the County has also passed a resolution dated the 16 day of APRIL, 1991, approving the specific jurisdictional transfer described herein, and

WHEREAS, Section 84.02(8), Wisconsin Statutes, enables the State to enter into jurisdictional transfer agreements with local units of government, thereby facilitating such alterations in jurisdictional highway systems,

NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereto do mutually agree to transfer jurisdictional responsibility for the following highways, effective upon completion of Project 5205-03-73.


