

Notice of Opportunity
for a Public Hearing on the Design Aspects of the Proposed
Construction on Water Street at the Intersections of Pine
Street and Main Street,
City of Platteville, Wisconsin

All interested persons are advised that the city of Platteville is planning the improvement of Water Street at the intersections of Pine and Main Streets. The work involved consists of increasing the radius at Main and Water Streets and the construction of a free flow right turn lane at Pine and Water Streets with traffic signals.

Inasmuch as federal-aid TOPICS funds may be used as part of the financing of this project, federal regulations, under Section 128 of Title 23, United States Code, requires that opportunity be afforded to all interested persons to request that a public hearing be held on the design aspects of the above project.

Information regarding the proposed improvement, including plans and right of way requirements as well as other documentation on the proposal, is available for inspection and copying at the office of the Director of Public Works, City of Platteville, 75 N. Bonson Street, Platteville, Wisconsin, 53818, telephone number (608) 349-6571.

Information is also available concerning the construction schedules and schedules for land acquisition at the Director of Public Works' office.

Relocation assistance is available to persons who may be displaced by the construction of this improvement. Any person who feels that he may be affected can obtain relocation assistance

information at the Division of Highways District Office at 1317 Applegate Road, Madison, Wisconsin, 53713, telephone number (608) 266-1125.

After contact with the inspection of the plans and documentation of the project at the office of the Director of Public Works, any person interested who may be affected by the proposed improvement may request that a public hearing be held. The hearing would consider the design aspects of the proposed construction, the economic, social and environmental impacts and effects of the improvement; and whether it is or is not in the public interest and consistent with the goals and objectives of such area planning as has been promulgated by the community.

The request for a public hearing may be made by delivering a written request to the office of the Director of Public Works on or before July 6, 1971. In event such a request is received, a further notice of the time and place of the hearing will be published.
