

ORDER BY HARRISON TOWN BOARD
FOR
RELOCATION AND ACQUISITION OF RIGHTS-OF-WAY
ON
BIG PLATTE ROAD

WHEREAS, the Harrison Town Board of Harrison Township, Grant County, Wisconsin, finds that the proper improvement or maintenance of the Big Platte Road described as follows:

Commencing at the S.E. Corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 20, T3N, R2W, said corner being the intersection of two fences; thence Due West 1110.35 feet; thence Due North 1344.50 feet to the point of beginning, said point being known as Station 20+00 and being at the intersection of the center line of Big Platte Road, a town road, and the northerly East-West $\frac{1}{4}$ - $\frac{1}{4}$ line of said section; thence N.12 $^{\circ}$ 34'W. for 111.00 feet to a point of curvature; thence 539.00 feet along the arc of a curve concave to the right with a radius of 381.97 feet to a point of tangency; thence N.68 $^{\circ}$ 17'E. for 250.00 feet; thence N.62 $^{\circ}$ 17'E for 200.00 feet to a point known as Station 31+00; thence S.74 $^{\circ}$ 47'W. for 350.00 feet;

requires certain relocations or changes, and the acquisition of certain Rights-of Way as shown on the attached plat marked "Plat of Right-of-Way required For Big Platte Road Bridge and Approaches, Big Platte Road and Quarry Road, Harrison Township, Grant County", dated July 12, 1982.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, under authority granted by Section 80.07 Wisconsin Statutes, that said town road be and is hereby changed or relocated and that Rights-of-Way be acquired in accordance with said plat.
