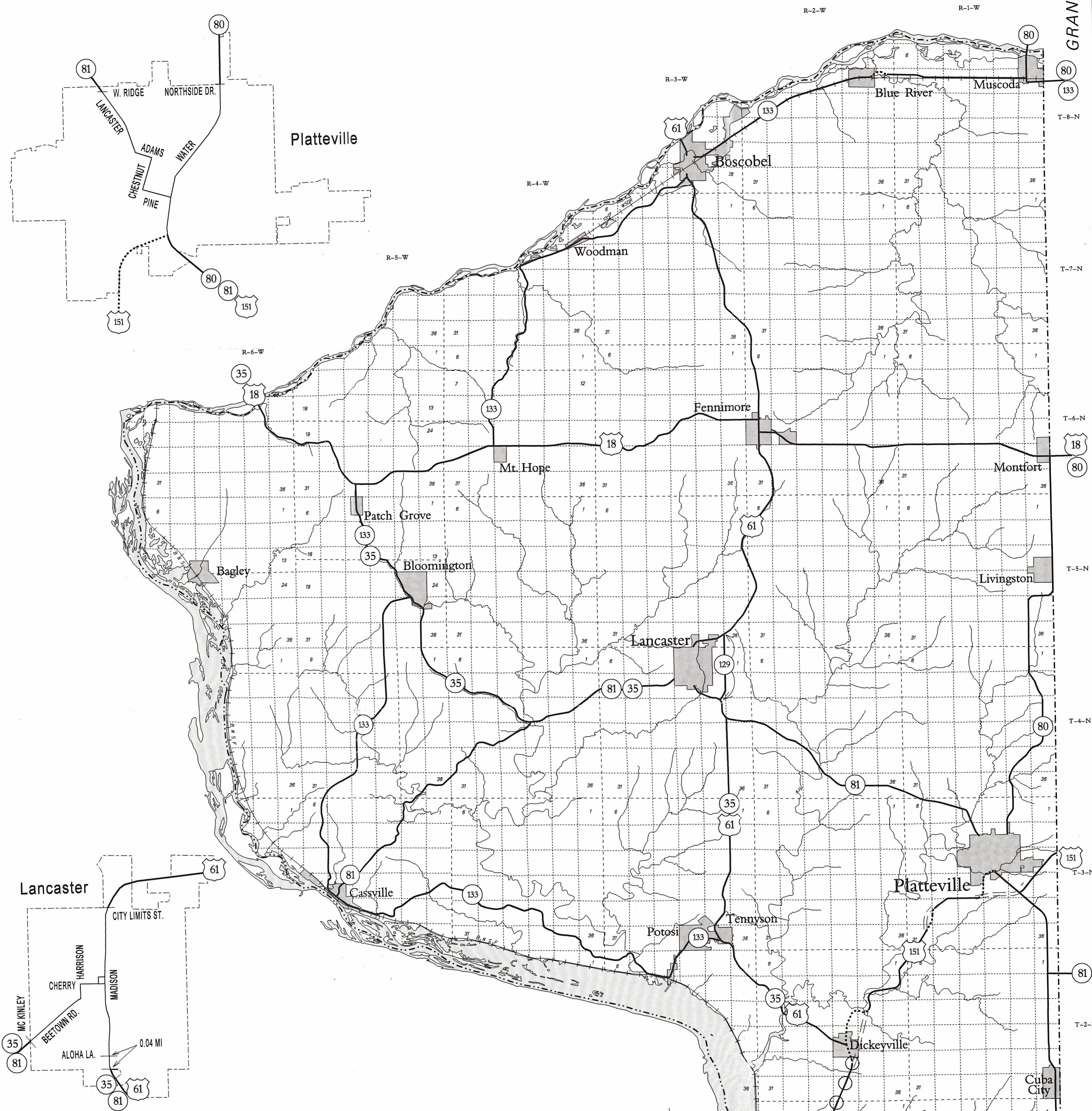
We will continue to send you yearly updates at the scale of 1/2 inch per mile as required by Wisconsin Statute.

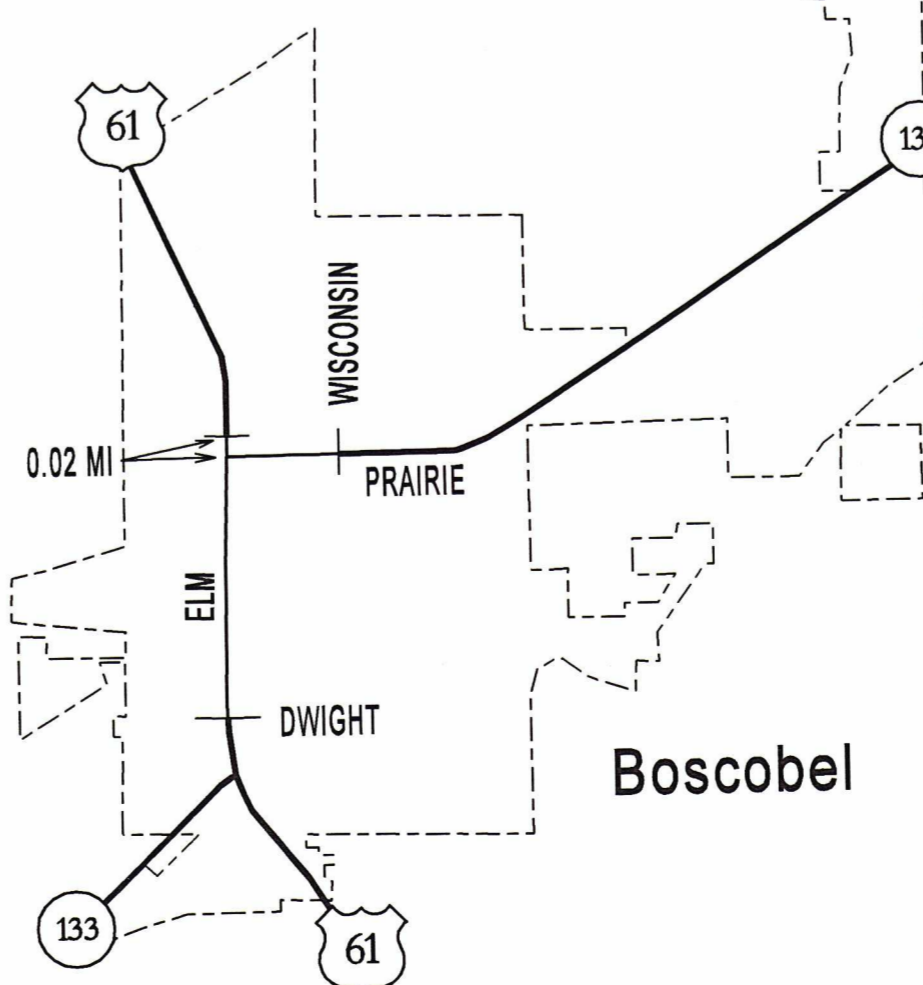
