STH 133 (North Street)
Village of Potosi, Grant County

This is to inform you that the Department of Transportation has on July 20, 1992, approved the attached agreement which was executed by the Village of Potosi, President on April 1, 1991. Under this agreement the state and the Village of Potosi agree to the jurisdictional transfer of 0.22 miles of State Trunk Highway (STH) 133 (North Street) to the Village street system. The Section of highway to be transferred is between the existing intersections with CTH "O" and CTH "U" in the Village. It is located near the center of Section 34, Town 3 North, Range 3 West, Grant County.

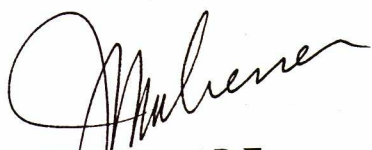
The attached agreement was made under the statutory authority of Section 84.02(8) of the Wisconsin Statutes. The jurisdictional transfer of this section of STH 133 to the Village will be effective when project I.D. 5205-03-73, for the reconstruction of CTH "O" from STH 133 to STH 35 is completed and opened to state trunk highway traffic.

For your information a separate agreement between the state and Grant County has also been approved. It transfers Existing STH 133 between CTH "U" and STH 35/61, to the county trunk system. It also transfers CTH "O" between STH 133 and STH 35/61 to the state trunk system.

JURISDICTIONAL TRANSFER AGREEMENT

This agreement, entered into this 1st day of July, 1991, by and between the Department of Transportation of the State of Wisconsin, hereinafter called the State, and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Potosi, Grant County, hereinafter called the Village:

WITNESSETH THAT:

WHEREAS, the functional/jurisdictional relationship of present State, County and local highway systems have been cooperatively reviewed by the Village and the Grant County Highway Committee and the State, and

WHEREAS, Section 84.02(8), Wisconsin Statutes, enables the State to enter into jurisdictional transfer agreements with local units of government, thereby facilitating such alterations in jurisdictional highway systems,

NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereto do mutually agree to transfer jurisdictional responsibility for the following highway, effective upon completion of Project 5205-03-73.

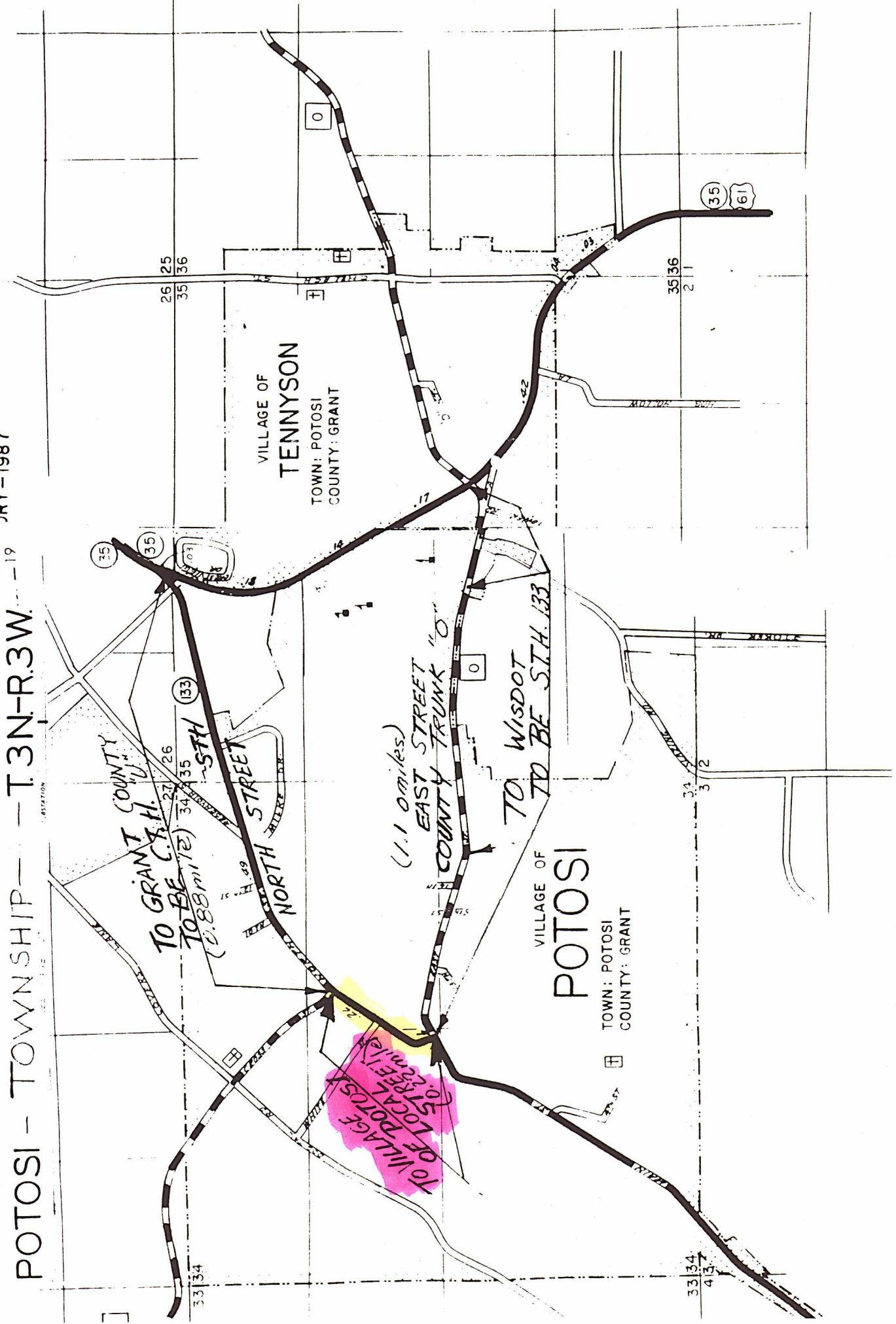

POTOSI - TOWNSHIP - T.3N-R.3W. - 19



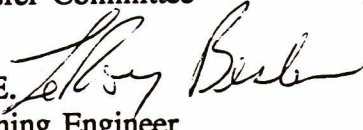
