Dear Local Official:

Please join us for a local officials meeting to discuss WIS 81 between US 61 and the east junction of Old Lancaster Road, located in Grant County, between Lancaster and Platteville.

The meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, February 20, 2019, from 4:00 – 5:00 pm, at the Wisconsin Bank and Trust, 10 Keystone Pkwy, Platteville, WI 53818. A public information meeting will follow this meeting beginning at 5:00pm.

A pavement replacement improvement project on this section of WIS 81 is currently scheduled to be constructed in 2021. Several deficiencies have been identified, including:

- Pavement – The existing asphalt surface and underlying rubbelized concrete pavement is not performing as expected and has deteriorated to a point where maintenance is no longer prudent.
- Structures – The following bridges are in need of minor repair:
 - WIS 81 over the Little Platte River (B-22-227)
 - WIS 81 over the Platte River (B-22-228)

Your input at the meeting, and throughout the design process, will help us deliver a successful highway project that will meet the safety and capacity requirements of the state highway system, while enhancing the highway's ability to serve the community's transportation needs.
