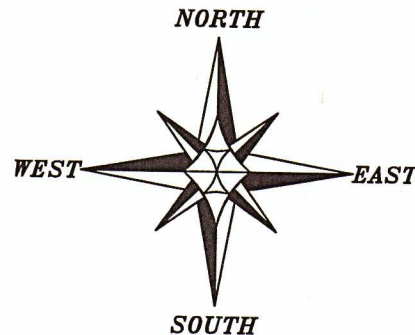
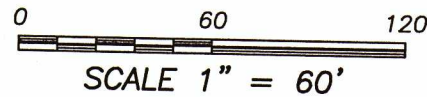


PLAT OF SURVEY

New tie sheet.

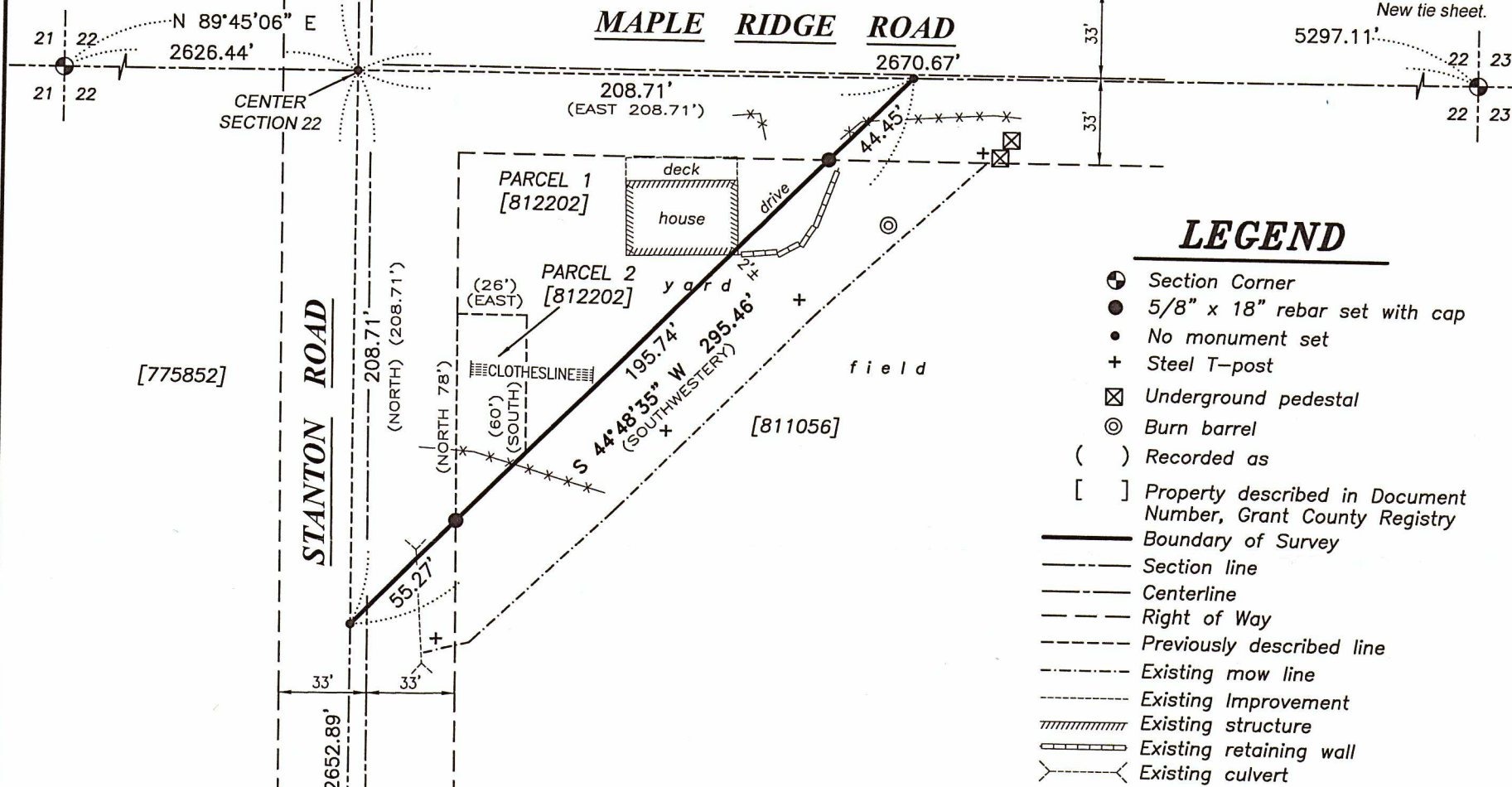

DESCRIPTION OF LINE SURVEYED:

Commencing at the West 1/4 corner of Section Twenty-two (22), Township Three (3) North, Range Two (2) West of the 4th P.M., Town of Harrison, Grant County, Wisconsin;
 thence North 89° 45' 06" East 2626.44 feet to the Center of said Section;
 thence North 89° 45' 06" East 208.71 feet along the North line of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of said Section;
 thence South 44° 48' 35" West 295.46 feet along a line of that property as described in Document Number 812202, Grant County Registry to a point on the West line of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of said Section which is located South 00° 07' 55" East 208.71 feet from the Center of said Section, said point being the terminus point.

SURVEYOR'S NOTES:

- The Center of Section was retraced by intersecting the North-South and East-West 1/4 lines. This is supported by a previous survey by Samuel Wilste dated 2-16-1844 filed in Book A, Page 202 of Grant County Surveys.
- The North line of the Southeast 1/4 and the West line of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 22 was utilized for retracement purposes of this survey. The description provided contained "dual calls" along the centerline of the roads and the aliquot lines. After reviewing adjoining descriptions, it was determined that the aliquot lines would be utilized to retrace the description. This was supported by the adjoining descriptions called for by aliquot lines and not centerlines of the roads. No overlaps or gaps are thereby created.
