

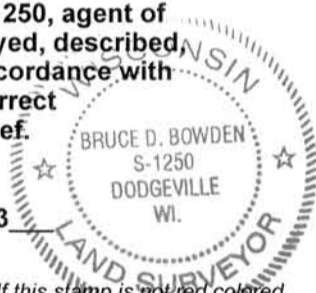
# Plat of Survey for Dallas Croft

Part of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 24,  
Town 6 North, Range 3 West, Mount Ida Township,  
Grant County, Wisconsin.

Commencing at the Southeast corner of Section 24; thence N 0°10'55"W on the East line thereof, 1328.35' to the Southeast corner of the said Northeast 1/4; thence N 89°46'56"W along the South line thereof to the point of beginning at the center lines of Roger Hollow Road and Mount Ridge Road; thence continuing N 89°46'56" W, 740.05' to a railroad spike; thence N 5°00'00" E, 331.73' to the West end of the quarry easement shown; thence continuing N 5°00'00" E, 218.92' a 1 1/2" dia. iron pipe; thence N 64°47'11" E, 55.06' to a 1 1/2" dia. iron pipe; thence S 74°08'07"E, 450.85' to a 1 1/2" dia. iron pipe; thence S 3°43'07" W, 105.18' to a 1" iron pipe; thence S 63°22'56"E through a 1" pipe, 329.46' to a point on the center line of Roger Hollow Road; thence S 27°57'57"W on said center line, 27.09' to the beginning of a 777.54' radius curve; thence Southwesterly 182.46' on the arc of said curve to the left, making a central angle of 13°26'43" and a long chord of 182.04' that bears S 21°26'34" W to a railroad spike and the point of beginning. Parcel contains 7.56 acres (329,417 square feet), more or less, and is subject to any and all easements and rights-of-way of record and/or usage. The quarry easement shown begins at the West end as described above; thence Easterly, 800.94' along the arc of a 1533.22' radius curve to the left making a central angle of 29°55'50" and a long chord of 791.86' that bears S 78°04'00"E to the center of Roger Hollow Road the the end of the easement.

Note: Bearings are referenced to the East Line of the SE 1/4 of Section 24, T6N, R3W, which bears S 0°10'55"E according to the Grant County Coordinate System as defined by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation and determined by GPS observation. Datum WGS 1984(2011)

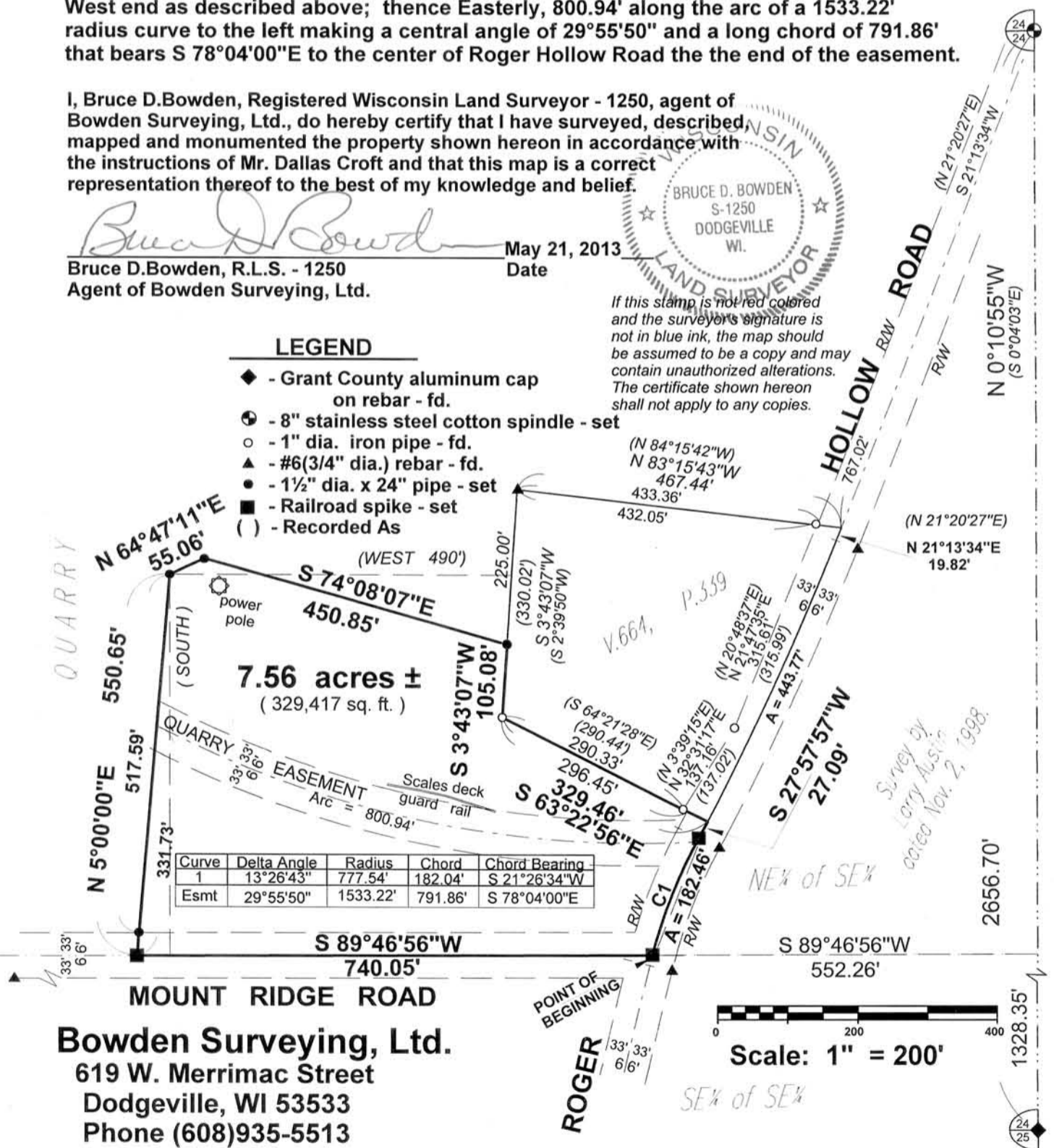
