
SURVEYORS CERTIFICATE

I, RODERICK D. STEEGE, Professional Land Surveyor for AECOM, do hereby certify that by the order of DTE STONEMAN LLC, I have surveyed and mapped part of Outlot 1, Certified Survey Map (C.S.M.) No. 1604 and part of Plat of Survey dated December 1, 1994 and revised May 15, 1996 by Robert M. Lampman and being located in part of Outlots 12, 13 and 14 to the Village of Cassville, all located in part of Government Lot 2, Section 29, Township 3 North, Range 5 West, Village of Cassville, Grant County, Wisconsin, described as follows:

Commencing at an existing stone monument at the Northeast corner of said Section 29;
Thence S 0°17'46" W, along the east line of said Section 29, 1626.49 feet, recorded as S 0°50'27" E;
Thence S 90° W, 1379.28 feet to an existing rebar on the southerly right of way line of Jack Oak Road and the Point of Beginning of the following traverse;
Thence S 79°03'48" W, 38.16 feet to an existing rebar, recorded as S 78°03'17" W, 38.12 feet
Thence S 44°07'34" W, 279.86 feet to an existing rebar, recorded as S 42°59'27" W, 279.89 feet;
Thence S 41°37'32" W, 15.00 feet to an existing rebar, recorded as S 40°17'04" W, 15.00 feet to a point of curvature;
Thence along the arc of a 73.34 foot radius curve to the right whose long chord bears S 30°25'53" E 45.90 feet to an existing rebar, recorded as S 31°29'26" E, 45.87 feet;
Thence S 12°06'28" E, 168.34 feet to an existing rebar, recorded as S 13°15'56" E, 168.35 feet;
Thence S 33°49'45" E, 299.37 feet, recorded as S 34°57'50" E, to the northerly corner of Outlot 1, C.S.M. No. 1604;
Thence continuing S 33°49'45" E, 65.00 feet, recorded as S 34°57'50" E, 64.98 feet to the north easterly corner of said Outlot 1;
Thence S 7°24'56" W, 467.75 feet, recorded as S 6°16'55" E, 467.78, to a meander corner;
Thence N 33°43'17" W, 369.10 feet, recorded N 34°50'50" W, 369.13 feet, along said mender line;
Thence N 47°22'38" E, 311.34 feet, recorded as N 46°14'47" E, 311.31 feet, to the end of said traverse.

Said survey was to locate existing monumented corners. Subject to any and all easements and/or restrictions of record.
