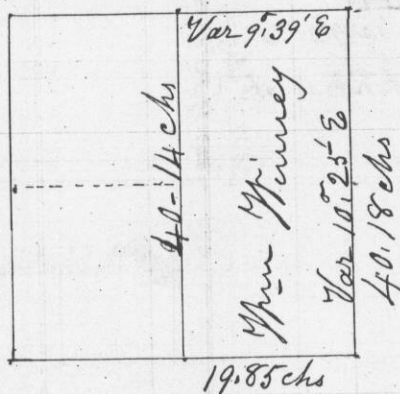

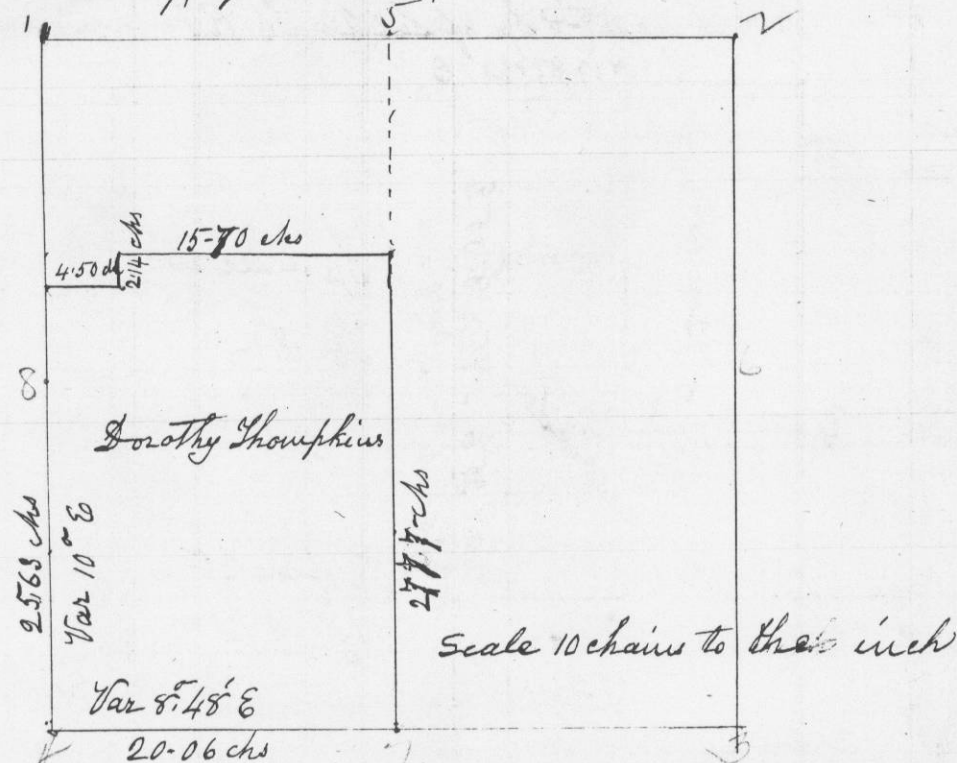
Corners all Established by running through the section from 1/4 post to 1/4 post each way + corners all appropriately marked and set in the prairie - no bearings
