Ascertained the position of the corners to Sections 19-24-25+30 from the bearing trees to the sections in Range 4 which are Br. Q. 12 N 87 1/2 E 7.48 Br. Q. 9 S 89 E 7.82

Set stake 18 links north of this corner for the sections in Range 5

Took bearings to this corner (for Bloomington) as follows Br. Q. 5 N 44 W 102 - Br. Q. 5 N 48 1/2 E 137

Ran South on town line from the corner for Sections 19+30 Variation 8° 30' E 39⁸⁶ fell 137 links east of the 1/4 sec. corner on west side section 30. Established 1/4 post for section 25 R 5 by one of the original bearing trees N 73. Aspen 10 S 21 W 22

Took new bearings to this corner White Oak 7 S 15 1/2 W 30 1/2 Butternut 4 N 20 W 19

Bearings for corner for 14 1/2 links south which is the 1/4 section corner for Section 30 R 4

Butternut 8 S 44 1/2 E 16 Butternut 7 N 46 1/2 E 7

Correct variation of line 6° 30' East
