Beginning at 1/4 post on line between Sections 27 & 34 where bears a B Oak 10 S 42° W 21 links & B Oak 10 N 68° W 36 links. thence run a random North through center of Section Bar 9° 15' E and intersect at 1/4 post between Sections 22 & 27.

Then from 1/4 post between Sections 28 & 29 and 28 run random East through center of Section Bar 8° 45' E chaining from intersection of North & South line through center of Section & at 39.95 chains intersect 1.64 chains North of 1/4 post between Sections 26 & 27. Corrected thence West
