

Record of Survey made for Joseph Walker on Section 10 Township 7 North Range 2 West by H. A. W. McCarair Deputy County Surveyor May 7<sup>th</sup> 1854

Commencing at corner of Sections 10, 11, 14 & 15. Run 8° 30' E. at 40.11 chains fell 11 links East of 1/4 Section past. Thence run West through center of Section Run 8° 35' E. at 80.48 chains intersect West boundary of Section 2.02 chains South of 1/4 past. East corrected 40.24 chains & set temporary center past. Then commencing at <sup>center</sup> past on South side of said Section 10 Run 8° 35' East ran North. at 39.96 chains fell 13 links East of temporary center past. At 80.11 chains fell 40 links East of 1/4 past on North boundary of said Section. Thence South corrected at 40.05 1/4 chains set 1/4 past in center of Section. Bearings White oak 7.875 E. 49 links. White oak 8. N 61 1/2 E. 67 links

Then commencing at said center past ran near on line Run 7° 8' East 12.46 chains set past. Bearings Br oak 8 S 39 1/2 E. 165 1/2 links. Thence South 1° 30' West 15.00 chains Bearing Hickory 6 N 76 E. 135 links. Thence S 77 1/4 E. to the North & South line through center of Section. Thence north on line (Run 8° 47' E) to place of beginning 18.17 chains.

Record of Survey made for John Lewis March 24<sup>th</sup> 1854 by Solomon Goodrich Deputy County Surveyor of the E 1/2 of A & 1/2 of Section 10 Township 5 North Range 5 West. Thomas Lewis & Martin Buzie having first been duly sworn as claimers.

Commencing at 1/4 Past between Sections 11 & 11 run thence West at a variation of 9° 20' East at 80.19 chains intersect Section line 40 links South of 1/4 Section past. Then from quarter section past between Sections 10 & 13 ran thence North Run 9° 10' East at 40. <sup>5 1/2</sup> chains intersect true line through center of Section <sup>chain</sup> at 80.55 chains intersect Section line 2 links East of past. Thence corrected South 40.32 1/4 chains & set past for quarter section corner. Thence corrected East 20.29 1/4 chains Run 8° 51' East and set past for 1/8 Section corner. Thence East same variation 20.29 1/4 chains to 1/4 Section past on line between Sections 10 & 11. Then commencing at corner of of Sections 2, 5, 10 & 11 ran West Run 9° 6' East, at 40.55 chains fell 23 links South of quarter Section corner. Thence corrected <sup>Run 9° 30' E</sup> East 20.26 1/2 chains & set past for 1/8 Section corner. Thence run South Run 9° 26' East at 40.15 chains intersect at 1/8 past on South side of said N.E. 1/4 Section.
