 & set stake for 1/8 section corner. thence from corner of
 sections 10. 11. 14 & 15 bearing 9° 10' East ran North at 40.28 chains
 fell 19 links East of 1/4 section corner between sections 10 & 11.

thence corrected South 20.14 chains bearing 9° 26' East to
 1/8 section corner. thence ran West variation 9° 10' East

 East to 1/4 section corner between sections 10 & 15. thence East
 bearing 9° 19' East 20.25 chains to 1/8 section corner previously established
 bearing Bunn^{ook} 10 S 22 1/4 W 114 links. Bunn^{ook} 8 N 74 W 179 links.
