Austin Ransom and Joel Hale Chainmen first  
duly sworn.

Commencing at corner of Sections 16, 17, 20 & 21, ran  
thence South on section line Variation 9° East 20.06 1/4 chains to  
1/4 Section corner East in Mound previously established in making  
Survey for David Sygel. Thence East Bar 8° 43' East 19.91 1/4  
chains to 1/4 Section corner East in Mound previously as aforesaid  
Thence North Variation 9° 25' East 20.06 chains to 1/4 Section corner  
on section corner line marked by post in Mound. Said  
corner established in making said Survey for Sygel. Thence  
East Bar 8° 33' East 19.83 1/4 chains to place of beginning marked by  
Baptist 8422.2  
Vol. 10. 1000 & N 39° W 84 links.

Deputy County Surveyor for David Michard of the S<sup>W</sup> 1/4 of N<sup>E</sup> 1/4  
of Section 21 Township 6 North Range 3 West Austin Ransom and Joel Hale Chainmen  
first duly sworn. Commencing at 1/4 Section corner between Sections  
21 & 22 marked by post in Mound ran thence North on section line Variation  
9° 12' East 19.98 1/4 chains to 1/4 Section corner found in making Survey this day  
for David Sygel & set post in Mound. Thence West Bar 8° 24' East 20.01 chains  
to 1/4 Section corner marked by post in Mound. Established in making the  
aforesaid Survey. Thence South Bar 8° 24' East 20.00 chains to 1/4 Section  
corner established in making said Survey marked by post in Mound. Thence  
East 19.90 1/4 chains Bar 8° 27' East to place of beginning.

Record of Survey made for John Heale April 22<sup>nd</sup> 1854  
by Solomon Goodrich Deputy County Surveyor of the N<sup>W</sup> 1/4 of Section  
22 Township 6 North Range 3 West David Michard & Henry Ammons  
first duly sworn as chainmen.

Commencing at corner of Sections 15, 16, 21 & 22 rounded  
thence East Variation 9° East at 40.00 chains the old quarter section  
corner having been obliterated. Set temporary 1/4 Section post at 19.60  
chains intersect section line 147 links north of corner of Sections 14, 15,  
22 & 23. Thence corrected West Bar 7° 57' East 39.80 chains & set post  
for quarter section corner in mound. Then commencing at  
1/4 Section corner between Sections 21 & 22 marked by post in Mound  
ran thence East Bar 8° East at 19.43 chains intersect section  
line 27 links north of post. Thence corrected West 39.71 1/4 chains  
& set temporary quarter section post in true East North  
Then commencing at 1/4 Section corner between Sections 15 & 22  
ran thence South Bar 9° East at 40.07 feet 11 links East of tem-  
porary center post. Thence continued South same variation  
at 39.77 chains fell 25 links East of quarter section <sup>corner</sup> set three  
Sections 22 & 27. Thence corrected north 39.92 chains Bar 8° 39'  
East & set post in mound for quarter section corner in  
center of Section. Thence corrected North 39.92 chains Variation  
8° 51' East to quarter section post corner between Sections 15 &  
22. Then from quarter section corner in center of said  
Section 22 corrected thence West 39.71 1/4 chains Variation 9° 13' East  
to 1/4 Section corner on line between Sections 21 & 22. Thence ran  
North on section line Variation 9° 12' East 39.97 links to corner of Sections  
15, 16, 22 & 22 the place of beginning marked by stone bearing  
1000. (S 88° E 467 links. 1000 & N 62° 29' E 292 links)
