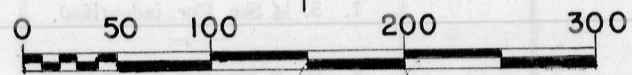


DESCRIPTION OF LAND TO BE PURCHASED BY THE CITY OF
FENNIMORE FROM JOHN KALILE.

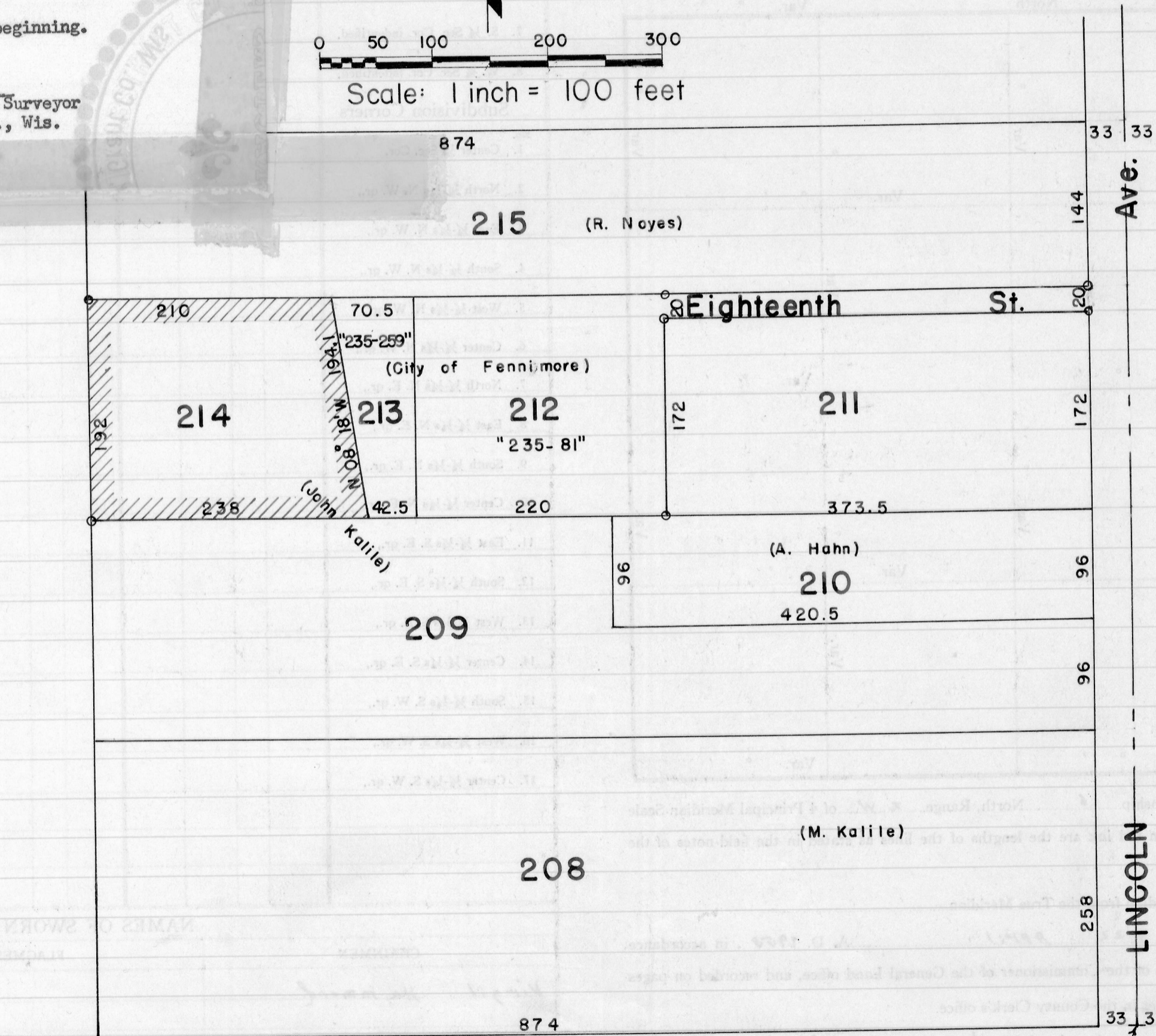
(Out Lot 211)

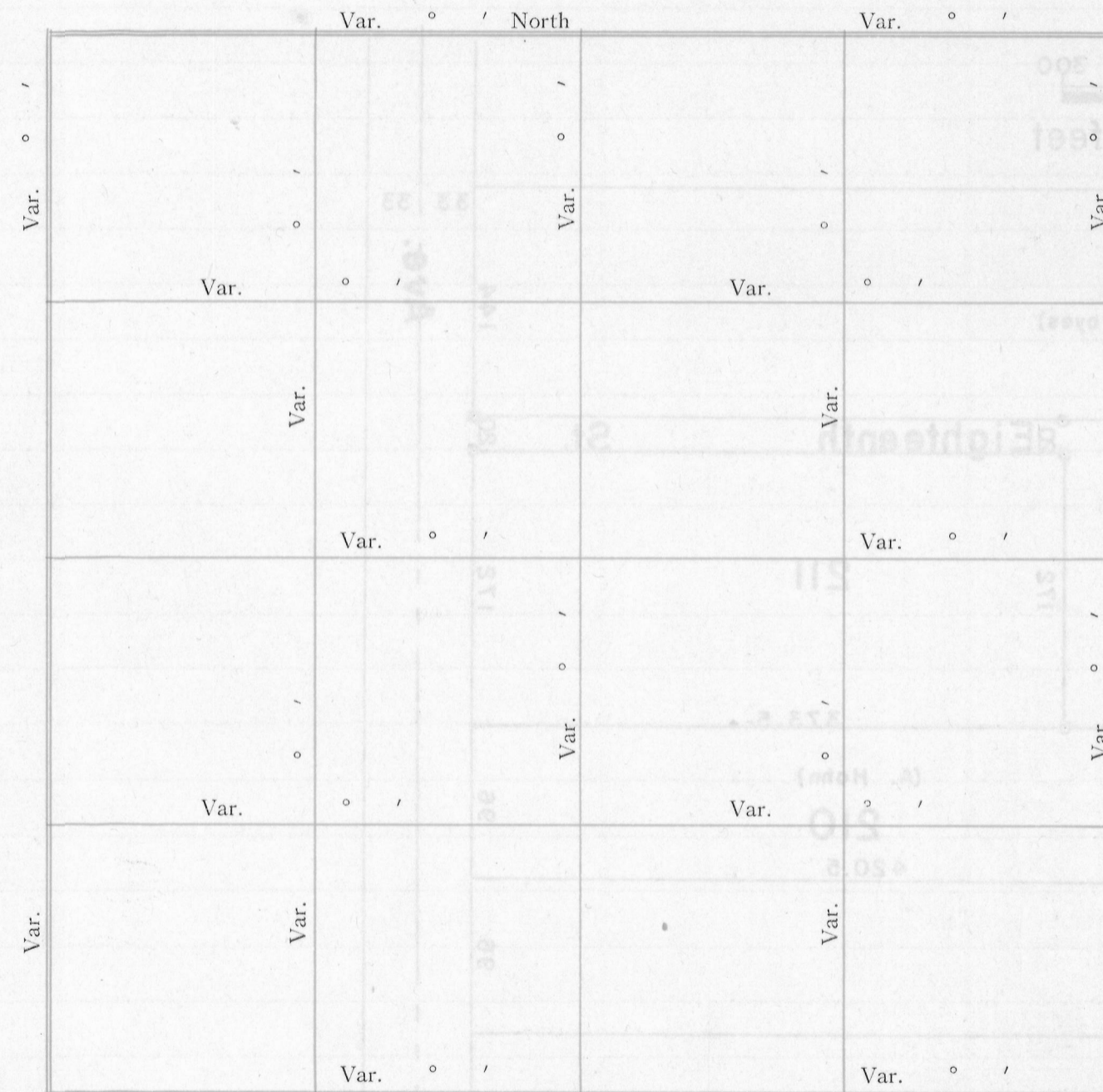
Record of Survey.

Township 6, North of Range 2 W of 4 Principal Meridian as presented by the courses and distances on the following plat, and annexed field-notes of survey:

Established the center of the section at the point of intersection of STRAIGHT quarter lines.

Established all quarter-quarter corners upon the section boundary at proportional distances between known section and quarter section corners, according to the original field-notes of the Government survey.

Established all lost corners at proportionate distances between known corners, according to the original field notes of the Government survey.



Plat of Section 19, Township 6 North, Range 2 W of 4 Principal Meridian Scale 80 chains to 6 inches. The figures in red ink are the lengths of the lines as stated in the field-notes of the Government survey.

Declination of the Magnetic Meridian from the True Meridian.....
