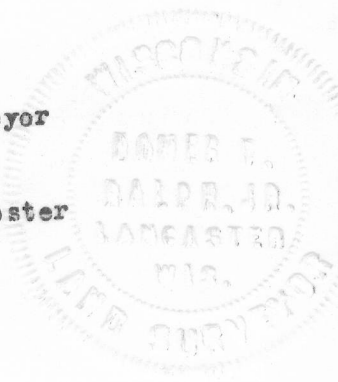


JEHOVAH WITNESS SURVEY

IN GRANT COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS, TO-WIT: BEGIN AT A POINT ON THE EAST BOUNDARY OF SHERIDAN STREET, WHICH IS 145.5 FEET SOUTH OF THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF LOT 1, BLOCK 10 OF RYLAND'S ADDITION TO THE VILLAGE (NOW CITY) OF LANCASTER; THENCE S 88° 45' E. 120 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 120 FEET; THENCE N 88° 45' W. 120 FEET; TO THE EAST BOUNDARY OF SHERIDAN STREET; THENCE NORTH 120 FEET ALONG SAID EAST BOUNDARY TO THE PLACE OF BEGINNING. THE ABOVE DESCRIBED TRACT OF LAND IS DESIGNATED ON THE ASSESSOR'S MAPS OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER AS A PART OF BLOCK 117.

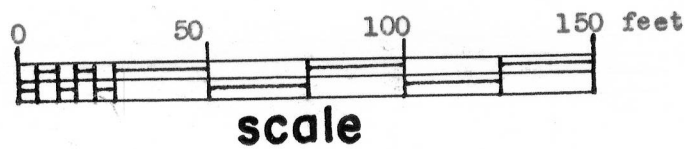
MAPLE ST.

Lot 1, Blk. 10, Ryland's Add., Lancaster.

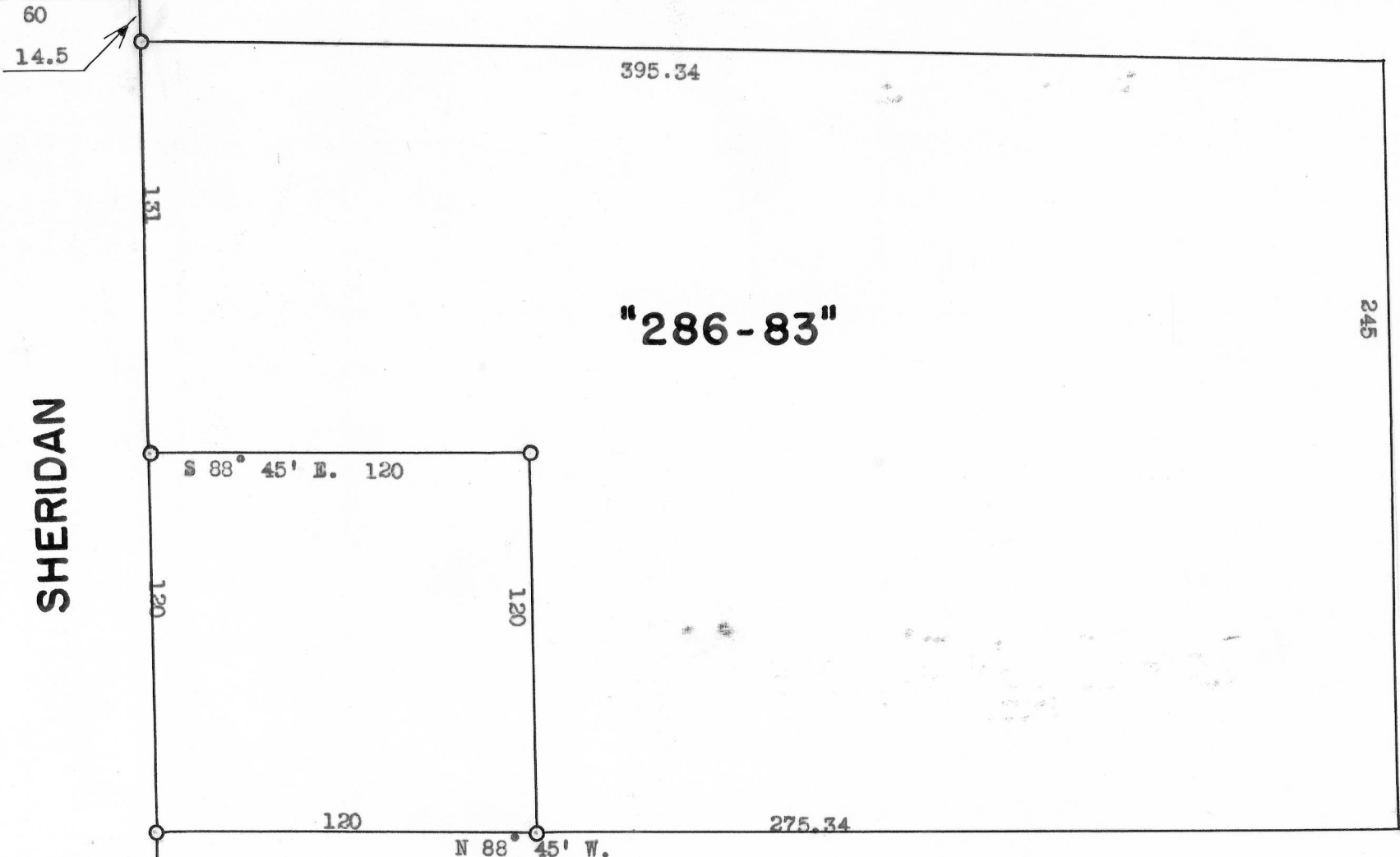
SHERIDAN ST.

OF SECTION, QUARTER SECTION AND QUARTER QUARTER SECTION CORNERS

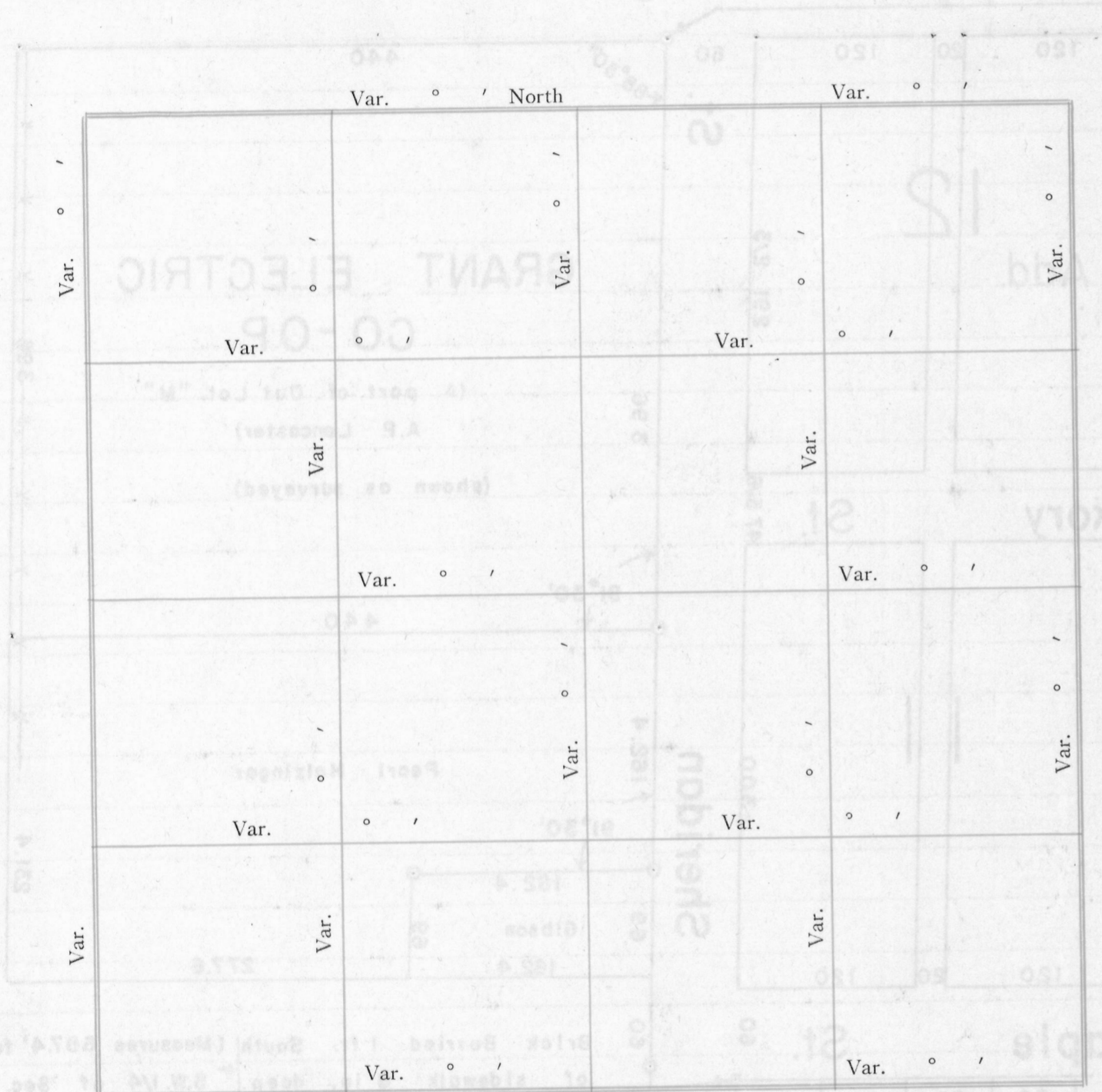
Form 1742 H. C. MILLER CO., MILWAUKEE

Township 4, North of Range 3 W of 4 Principal Meridian as presented by the courses and distances on the following plat, and annexed field-notes of survey:

Established the center of the section at the point of intersection of STRAIGHT quarter lines.

Established all quarter-quarter corners upon the section boundary at proportional distances between known section and quarter section corners, according to the original field-notes of the Government survey.

Established all lost corners at proportionate distances between known corners, according to the original field notes of the Government survey.



Plat of Section 2, Township 4 North, Range 3 W of 4 Principal Meridian Scale 80 chains to 6 inches. The figures in red ink are the lengths of the lines as stated in the field-notes of the Government survey.

Declination of the Magnetic Meridian from the True Meridian.....
