

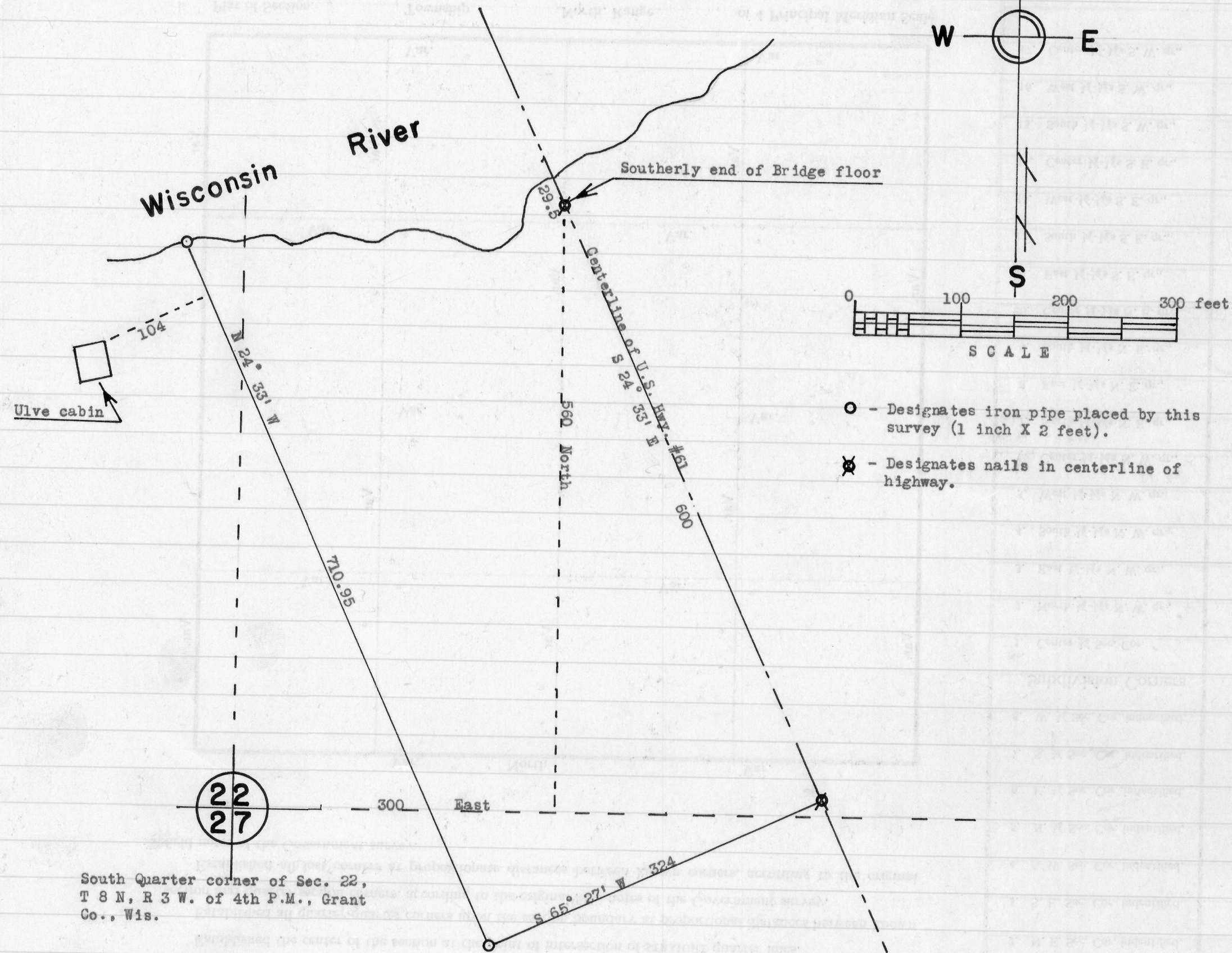
# LYLE K. ULVE - GRANT COUNTY SURVEY (Proposed boat landing and parking area)

## DESCRIPTION OF LANDS TO BE CONVEYED TO GRANT COUNTY, WISCONSIN BY LYLE K. ULVE.

Begin at a point on the Centerline of U.S. Highway #61 at the Southerly end of the Bridge floor, which is 560 feet North and 300 feet East from the South Quarter corner of Section 22, T 8 N, R 3 W. of the 4th P.M., Grant County, Wisconsin; thence South 24° 33' East 600 feet along said centerline; thence South 65° 27' West 324 feet; thence North 24° 33' West 710.95 feet to a point on the Southerly bank of the Wisconsin River; thence Easterly on a meandering course along the water's edge to the Centerline of said Highway; thence South 24° 33' East 29.5 feet along said centerline to the place of beginning.

The above described lands are designated as part of Lots 4, 5 and 7 of Section 22, and part of Lot 1, Section 27 on the Assessor's Plat of the City of Boscobel; the above described lands also include part of the S.E.1/4 of S.W.1/4 of said Section 22 in the Township of Boscobel.
