Thence South 00°43' West 44.05 feet;

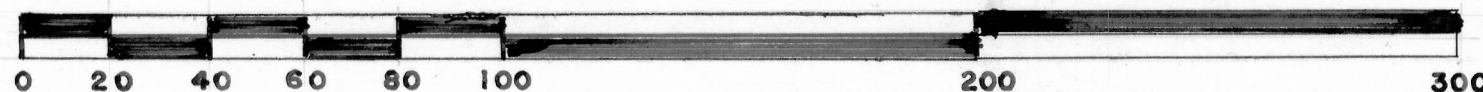
Thence North 88°51' East 179.00 feet to the center-
