DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY OWNED BY
WISCONSIN POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY
IN
BLOOMINGTON, WIS.

This property is the site of the present 34.5 KV Substation.

Property checked with deed description in September, 1954, by D. S. Fowler and T. W. Phipps.

Property described by Warranty Deed recorded in Register of Deeds Office, Grant County, Wisconsin, in Vol. 204 of Deeds, on page 602.

Description of Property -

All that part of the N.E.1/4 of Section 26-T5N-R5W described as follows: Beginning at an iron pipe in the easterly line of the Glen Haven Road and 266 feet southwesterly of the intersection of the southerly line of Canal Street, in the Village of Bloomington, with the easterly line of said Glen Haven Road, said iron pipe being further described as being 4 feet southwesterly of the southwest corner of the Knapp and Hillery Garage; thence southeasterly parallel to and 4 feet southwesterly of said garage, for 123.5 feet to an iron pipe; thence southwesterly for 300 feet more or less to the center of the Creek; thence northwesterly along the center of the Creek to the easterly line of the said Glen Haven Road; thence northeasterly along the easterly line of said Glen Haven Road to the place of beginning.
