WE BELIEVE THE WHITE OAK AS SHOWN ON THE PRINT TO BE ONE OF THE WITNESS TREES FROM THE ORIGINAL GOVERNMENT SURVEY IN THIS AREA. THE BEARING WE HAD TO THIS TREE WAS N 42° W BASED ON OUR ASSUMPTION FOR BEARINGS - (1/4 LINE BEING DUE "NORTH" - OUR TIE WAS 19' FROM THE TREE WHICH IS APPROX. 42" IN DIAMETER NOW -

WE OFFER THIS INFORMATION FOR YOUR USE IN RE-ESTABLISHING THE 1/4 CORNER AND IF WE CAN BE OF FURTHER ASSISTANCE, PLEASE LET US KNOW - I HAVE BEEN WORKING WITH CHUCK LEUCK OF FENNIMORE, WIS., ON THIS SURVEY.
