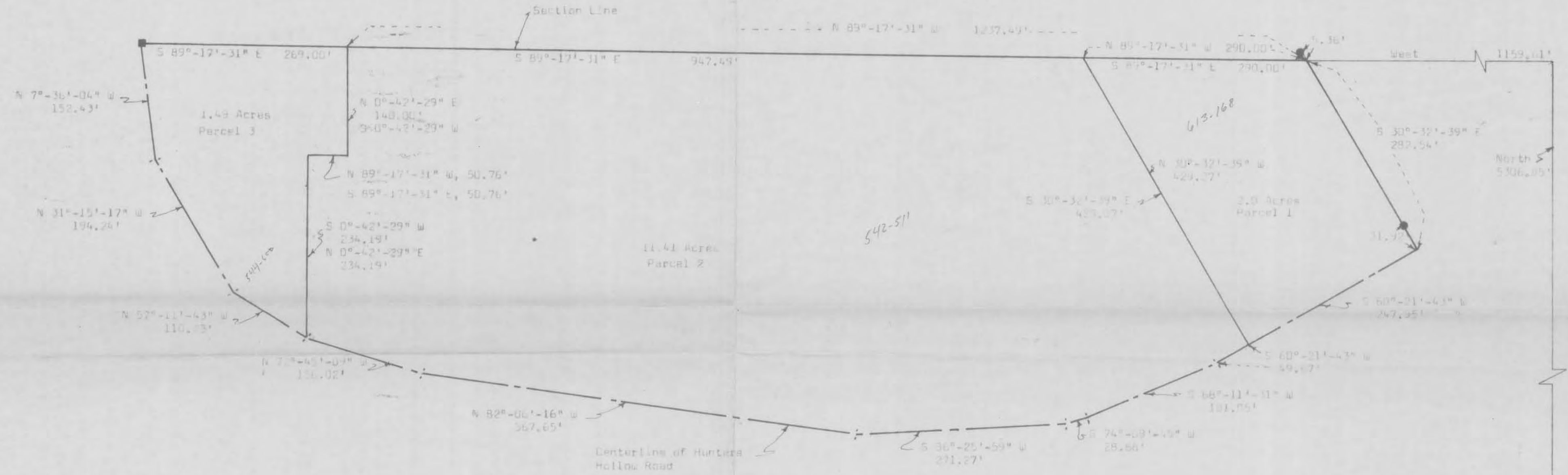

LANDS OWNED BY GEORGE HOWELL



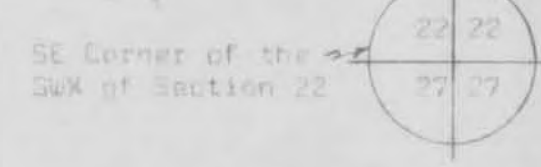



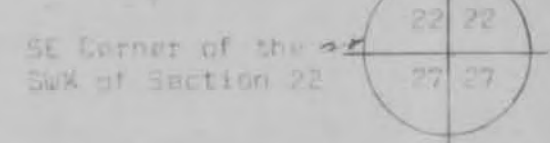
LANDS OWNED BY GEORGE HOWELL
