I hereby certify the above is a true and correct plat of the survey of the following described property: A parcel of land in the west 1/2 of South east One-quarter of Section 33, T. 1 N., R. 2 W. of 4 Principal Meridian: Commencing at the South East Corner of Southeast One-quarter of Section 33, Township 1 North, Range 2 West of 4 Principal Meridian, thence west on State line between Wisconsin and Illinois 1,624.07 feet to point of beginning of property to be described; Thence north $33^{\circ}07'$ West 94.26 feet, thence north 77° West 152.73 feet, thence west 261.09 feet, thence south 138.2 feet to state line, thence east on said state line 457.73 feet to point of beginning, containing 1.19 acres, subject to land used for highway purposes by State of Wisconsin, being in Jamestown Township, Grant County, Wisconsin.

A parcel of land in fractional section 16, Township 29, Range 2 West of 4th Principal Meridian: Commencing at the northeast corner of said Section 16, thence west on State line between Illinois and Wisconsin 1,352.28' to point of beginning of property to be described; thence west 318.87 feet on said State line, thence south 134.11 feet to northerly right of way line of Illinois State Bond Issue Route No. 79 or Wisconsin Highway 35, thence easterly and concave northerly along the northerly Right of Way Line of said highway on a $11^{\circ}00'$ curve a distance of 209.08 feet, thence north $59^{\circ}48'$ east 142.5 feet along the northerly right of way line of said highway to point of beginning, containing 0.59 acres, being in Danleith Township, Jo Daviess County, Illinois, as surveyed and platted by me.
