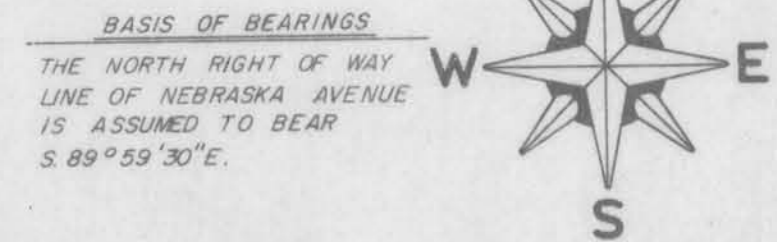


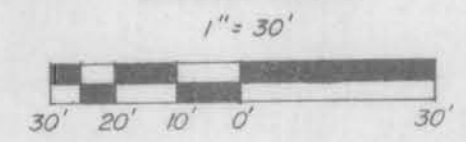
# MAP OF SURVEY

### SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

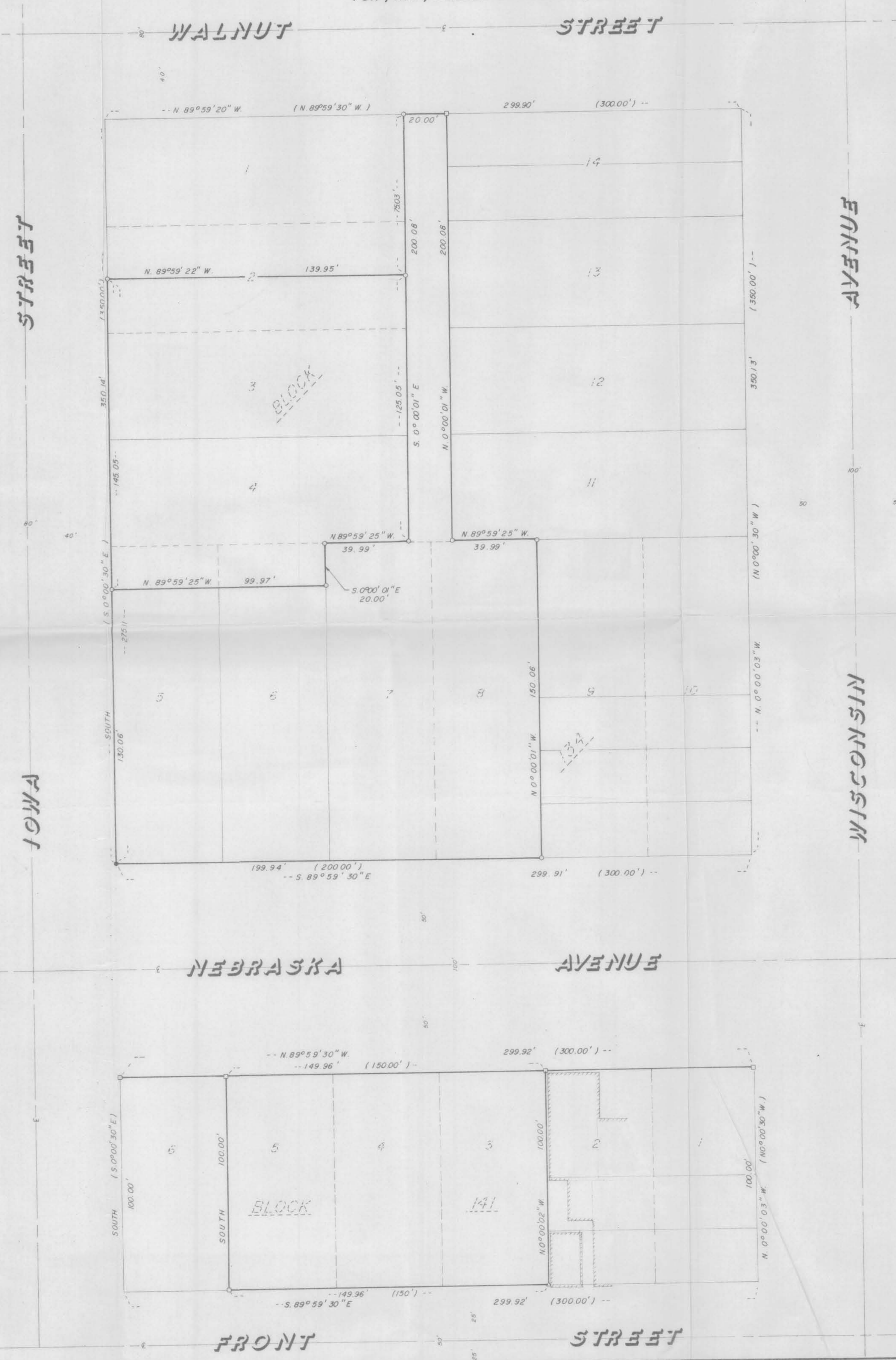
