DESCRIPTION FOR THE CITY OF BOSCOBEL

All that part of the Southeast One-quarter of the Southwest One-quarter and part of the Southwest One-quarter of the Southeast One-quarter, all in Section 27, Township 8 North, Range 3 West, Town of Boscobel and City of Boscobel, Grant County, Wisconsin, bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at the South One-quarter corner of Section 27; thence North 81° 26' 42" West, along the North boundary of the "Old Dump Road", 844.92 feet; thence North 82° 23' 21" West, along the North boundary of the "Old Dump Road", 502.41 feet to a point on the West line of the Southeast One-quarter of the Southwest One-quarter of Section 27; thence North 00° 00' 34" East, along said West line, 1127.00 feet to the Northwest corner of the Southeast One-quarter of the Southwest One-quarter of Section 27; thence North 89° 55' 25" East, along the North line of the Southeast One-quarter of the Southwest One-quarter of Section 27, 1333.27 feet to the Northeast Corner of the Southeast One-quarter of the Southwest One-quarter of Section 27; thence South 00° 00' 15" East, along the East line of the Southeast One-quarter of the Southwest One-quarter, 364.15 feet to the Northwest corner of Outlot 37 of the Assessors Plat of the City of Boscobel; thence South 89° 46' 25" East along the North line of said Outlot 37, 34.36 feet to the Northeast corner of said Outlot 37; thence South 00° 11' 03" East along the East line of said Outlot 37, 923.92 feet to the Southeast corner of said Outlot 37; thence North 89° 46' 25" West, along the South line of said Outlot 37, 37.27 feet to a point on the East line of the Southeast One-quarter of the Southwest One-quarter; thence South 00° 00' 15" East, along said East line, 32.96 feet to the place of beginning, containing 1,661,662.8 square feet or 38.147 acres of land.
