
DESCRIPTION:

Of a parcel of land located in the Northeast 1/4, Northeast 1/4; the Northeast 1/4, Southeast 1/4 and Southwest 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 33, T1N R2W of the 4th P.M., Grant County, Wisconsin, said parcel being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of Section 33, T1N R2W of the 4th P.M., Grant County, Wisconsin;  
THENCE N 89°18'20" W 1325.92' to the Northwest corner of the Northeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of said Section 33;  
THENCE S 00°29'38" W 1099.50' to a 3/4" iron bar marking the point of beginning;  
THENCE S 00°29'38" W 220.29' to a 3/4" iron bar marking the Southwest corner of the Northeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of said Section 33;  
THENCE N 89°26'16" W 16.50' to a 3/4" iron bar on the North line of the South 1/2 of Northeast 1/4 of said Section 33;  
THENCE S 00°29'38" W 281.55' to a 3/4" iron bar;  
THENCE S 88°49'33" E 415.54' to a 3/4" iron bar;  
THENCE N 02°43'49" W 186.34' to a 3/4" iron bar;  
THENCE N 24°33'37" W 107.70' to a 3/4" iron bar;  
THENCE N 11°30'17" W 131.53' to a 3/4" iron bar;  
THENCE N 40°15'19" W 101.60' to a 3/4" iron bar;  
THENCE N 86°11'28" W 90.57' to a 3/4" iron bar;  
THENCE Westerly 159.33' on the arc of a curve concave Northerly, having a radius of 4693.66' and a long chord which bears N 85°05'10" W 159.32' to the point of beginning, containing 4.103 acres, more or less, and being subject to any and all easements of record.

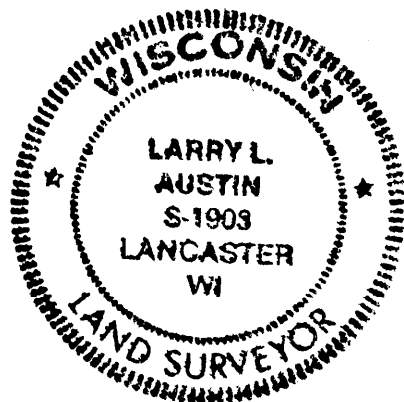
