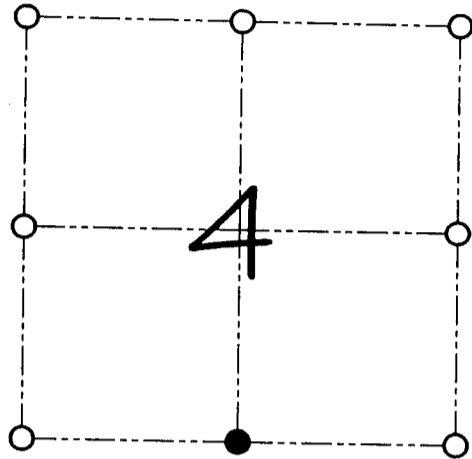

In 1855 Overton found the original corner.

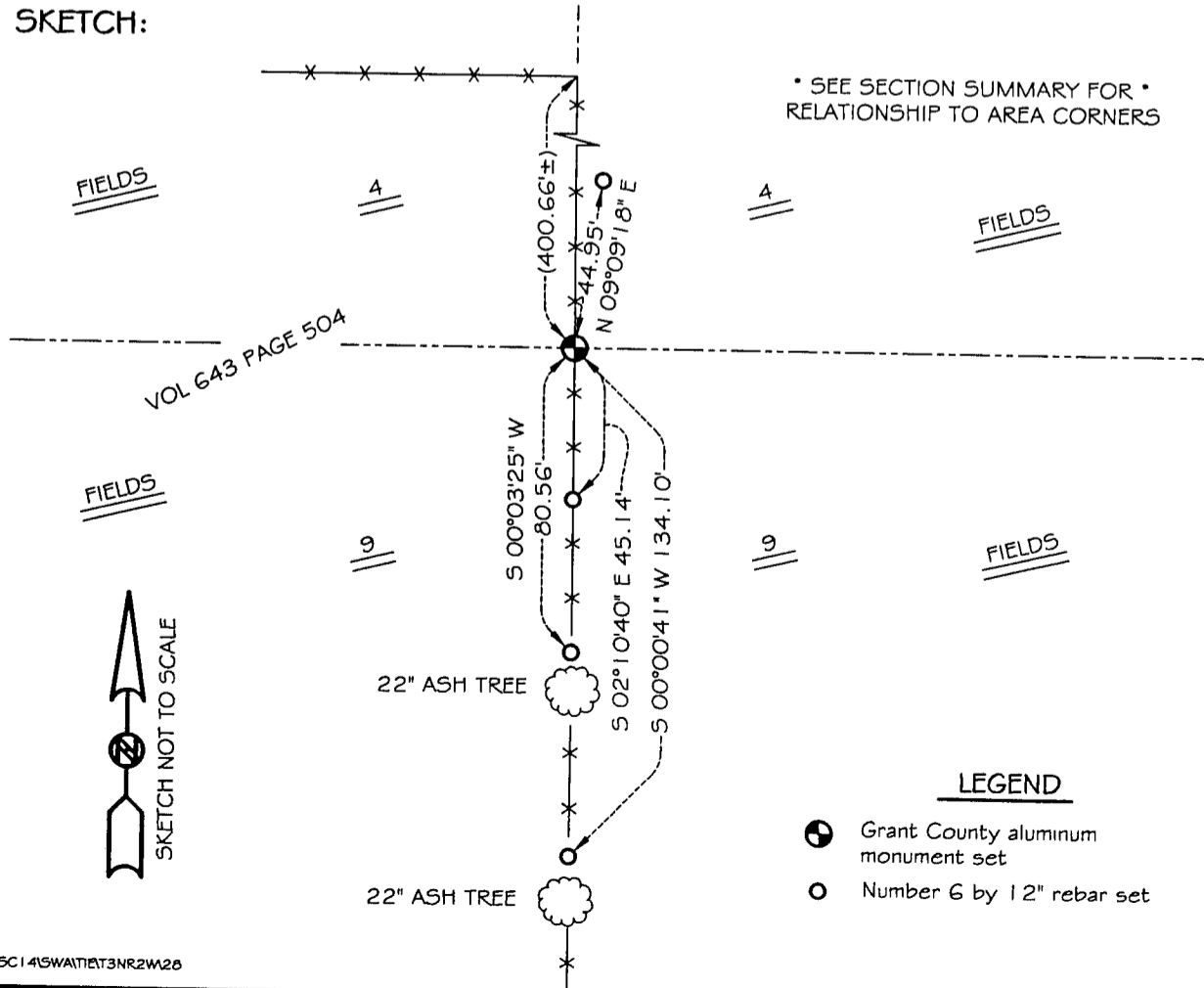
**DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:**

I reset the corner at the recorded distance on Volume 643, Page 504 from the occupied fence corner. The Easting was set proportionately between the Southwest and Southeast corners. Verified this location using E.D.M. methods.
