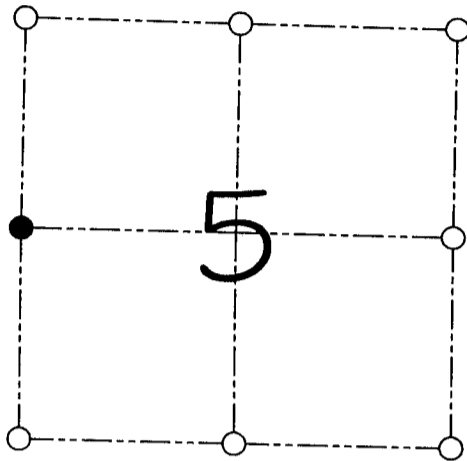

In 1889 Herbert Gould found the original corner.

I reset the corner based on the measurements to the West line of the Southwest Quarter. Verified this location using E.D.M. & G.P.S. methods.
